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1. EVENTS – EAST EUROPEAN ACCURACY LEAGUE 2026 (ROUND 5)

Round 5 of the East European Accuracy League 2026 consists of precision landing competition jumps held at Zărnești Airfield, contributing to the official team and individual rankings of the League.

2. ORGANISERS

The East European Accuracy League (EEAL) – Zărnești stage is organized by **Aeroclub “Vreau să zbor”**, headquartered in Râșnov, Brașov County, under the patronage of **Mr. Cătălin Bălascău**, with the support of:

a) **Piatra Craiului Airfield** – provides the necessary infrastructure and awards the “*Piatra Craiului*” Cup.

b) **General Grigore Baștan Foundation** – awards the “*Major General Grigore Baștan*” Cup.

c) **National Association of Parachutists of Romania (ANPR)** – supports the competition with qualified personnel and awards the “*Gheorghe Iancu*” Cup and three trophies.

d) **Aerosquad Sports Club** – assists the event with qualified personnel.

The organizer may collaborate with other entities to ensure optimal conditions and achieve the event’s objectives.

3. AIM OF THE COMPETITION

a) Improve technical skills and landing accuracy.

b) Create a friendly and competitive environment for experience exchange.

c) Promote safety practices among parachutists and organizers.

d) Offer awards and recognition for outstanding performances.

e) Encourage development of professional competition infrastructure.

4. VENUE, DATE AND STAFF

a) **Location:** Zărnești Airfield – Romania **Distance:** 16 km from Brașov; 7 km from Bran Castle;

b) **Coordinates:** 45°33'51.0"N 25°23'57.0"E **Elevation:** 720 m (2120 ft);

c) **Date:** 02–04 October 2026;

d) **Chief Organiser:** Cătălin BĂLĂȘCĂU;

5. ACCOMMODATION

a) Hotels and guesthouses in the village near the airfield. Accommodation will be 20 euro/person/night and must be booked in advance at **catabalascau@yahoo.com**;

b) Tents at Zărnești Airfield (free of charge).

6. DROP ZONE FACILITIES

a) Briefing area;

b) Office center;

- d) Parking areas.

8. REGISTRATION

8.1. Eligibility

Competitors must:

- a) be at least 16 years old;
- b) hold a valid parachutist license issued by a recognized organization;
- c) present a valid medical certificate confirming fitness for parachuting;
- d) use parachuting equipment meeting organizer safety standards;
- e) note that competitors previously disqualified for unsportsmanlike conduct may be excluded.

8.2. Registration Procedure

- a) Complete the official registration form.
- b) Present parachutist license and medical certificate.
- c) Organizer sends confirmation e-mail after verification.
- d) All documents must be submitted before arrival; missing or non-compliant documents may lead to disqualification.

9. ENTRY FORMS

Entry forms must be received no later than **25 September 2026**. Late registrations are subject to a late fee.

10. ENTRY FEES

Deadline for entry fees: **02 October 2026**. Delegations that do not pay on time are not allowed to participate. No refunds for competitors who withdraw.

Competitor's fee: 180 Euro per person

Entry fee covers: Registration fee; 8 competition jumps 160 euro (min. 4 – max. 8) and Final EEAL award ceremony, 20 euro.

11. SAFETY CONDITIONS

11.1. Safety Equipment

All equipment must meet organizer safety standards. Main and reserve parachutes must be inspected and certified. **ADD is not mandatory but is recommended.**

Protective helmet/bonnet **must be worn.**

11.2. Equipment Check

Competitors must perform a full equipment check before each jump.

11.3. Safety Briefing

Mandatory safety briefing before competition starts.

11.4. Landing Area

Landing zone is marked and free of obstacles; ground personnel assist if needed.

11.5. Emergency Measures

Emergency procedures implemented by organizers.

11.6. Weather Monitoring

Weather continuously monitored; unsafe conditions may delay or cancel jumps.

12. JUDGING EQUIPMENT

a) Electronic Accuracy Landing Measuring Device (AMD)

b) Real-time weather monitoring systems

13. PROTEST PROCEDURES

Protests must be submitted within **60 minutes** of round results. Submitted by team captain.
Protest fee: **20 Euro**.

If protest is accepted, fee is refunded.

14. AWARDS

14.1. Stage Awards

Granted by the Competition Organizer

a) **Team Accuracy** – 1st, 2nd, 3rd place;

b) **Individual Men** – 1st, 2nd, 3rd place;

c) **Individual Women** – 1st, 2nd, 3rd place.

14.2. Overall EEAL 2026 Awards

Granted by the EEAL Director Council

a) **Team Accuracy – EEAL 2026 Overall** – 1st, 2nd, 3rd place;

b) **Individual Junior - EEAL 2026 Overall** – 1st, 2nd, 3rd place;

c) **Individual Men – EEAL 2026 Overall** – 1st, 2nd, 3rd place;

d) **Individual Women – EEAL 2026 Overall** – 1st, 2nd, 3rd place.

14.3. Partner Awards

a) **“Piatra Craiului” Cup** *Offered by Piatra Craiului Airfield*; awarded for best results in **Rounds 1 & 3**;

b) **„Major General Grigore Baștan” Cup** *Offered by the Major General Grigore Baștan Foundation*; awarded for best team results in **Rounds 2 & 4**;

c) **„Gheorghe Iancu” Cup** *Offered by the National Association of Parachutists of Romania (ANPR)*; awarded to the team with the **highest number of 0 cm results overall**.

14.4. Special Awards

a) **„Cristinel Jianu” Trophy** *Offered by the National Association of Parachutists of Romania (ANPR)*; awarded to the **1st place Men**;

b) **„Ecaterina Diaconu” Trophy** *Offered by the National Association of Parachutists of Romania (ANPR)*; awarded to the **1st place Women**;

c) **„Mugurel Uță” Trophy** *Offered by the National Association of Parachutists of Romania (ANPR)*; awarded for the **highest number of 0 cm results**.
