1. The competition will take place at airfield in Metelin (N50°44'43,6" E23°50'13,4") on July 31, 2026, and on August 01-02, 2026 at the Hrubieszow Sports and Recreation Center (training field, N50°48'14,3" E23°52'47,9"). They will be conducted in accordance with the FAI rules and EEAC regulations posted on the website www.eeacup.eu.

2. The program of the competition:

- 31.07.2026 - 08.00-09.30 - registration of competitors,
- 09.30-10.00 - technical briefing,
- 10.15-10.45 - opening of the competition,
- 11.00-19.00 - playing the competition,
01.08.2026 - 8.00-19.00 - playing the competition,
- 20.00 - grill for participants, Metelin,
02.08.2026 - 9.00-13.00 - playing the competition,
- 15.00 - competition closing ceremony.

Competition may end earlier if all jumps have been completed or if the weather makes it impossible to do so. The end of the competition will take place the 2 hours after the end of the jumps.

3. The competition is organised by the Military Sport Club WAWEL, the member of Polish Aero Club – Polish Association of Air Sports. The organization is supported by: the City of Hrubieszow, the 2nd Hrubieszow Reconnaissance Regiment of the name of Maj. Henryk Dobrzanski HUBAL, the Aeroclub of Zamosc and Mr. Bogdan Jasina.

Event partners are: Sulewski Brewery, Municipal Heat Supply Company in Krakow, PARASNAKE Arkadiusz Szewczyk, PWiTPO Sławomir Weremczuk, WiST DRACZKOWSKI, Wojciechowa Stajnia Hrubieszow.

4. The competitions:

- team accuracy landing:

- 8 rounds (minimum 4),
- teams can be mixed,
- teams are four-person,
- individual accuracy landing:
- 8 rounds (minimum 4).

5. The starting fee for the participation in the East European Accuracy League Hrubieszow 2026 is 160 EUR per competitor. Fees are paid at the time of registration in the competition office. The rules provide the refund in case the competition will not take place for the fault of the organizer - including weather conditions, then we return 10 EUR for the jump of one competitor. The organizer does not allow payment in a different currency. As part of the entry fee, each participant is provided with parachute jumps.

6. Participants of the competition must have FAI sports licenses, medical examinations entitling them to practice parachute sports and insurance policies against civil liability related to the performance of parachute jumps.

6. The entry form – check attachment 1 - must be sent no later than 24.00 of 23.07.2026 to the following address: ama.gosiewska@gmail.com.

7. The number of competitors is limited to 40.

8. The competition rules described in attachment 2 will be applied.

9. The jumps will be performed from the Cessnas 182.

10. The organizer does provide the possibility of free accommodation in their own tents. The organizer provides possible help in booking accommodation in Hrubieszow at a price from EUR 12 per person per night, in boarding school-style facilities (Hotel Elf) and at prices ranging from EUR 21 to EUR 37 per person per night, at Hotel Magnolia. The number of places at this price is limited. The cost of accommodation is not included in the entry fee and is borne by the competitors individually. In the entry form, please indicate whether you will use the accommodation offered by the organizer.
