8/ Conditions of entry

- Participation is based on registration;
- The organisers accept the entries of the first 15 teams, not including those invited
- Teams consist of 4 (four) competitors;
- Teams can be mixed (male-female) and team members may be members of different parachuting clubs;
- Entries can be made on the entry form attached to this announcement;

9/ Rules of competition

- The event is an accuracy landing competition;
- The competition rounds will be team accuracy landing jumps, and the individual

ranking will be determined based on the individual results of the team rounds;

- Number of jumps: max. 8, min. 4; jumps are also counted in the individual evaluation.
- The exit altitude is between 900-1100 m;
- Aircraft: C-182;
- Pilot: Norbert Bartos, Gábor Nacsa

Judging

The landing point is the first point of contact with the surface. Landing is measured from 0 to 16 cm (pts) by the automatic measuring device (AMD).

- Documents of the equipment.

The licences, certificates and other documents will be checked by the organizers. Please note, that all documents should be valid until the closing date of the competition. In any question regarding the competition and not specified in this announcement, the FAI code will be followed. The chief instructor of every participating parachuting club is to declare that the competitors possess the skills necessary to participate in the accuracy landing competition.

Protests have to be submitted to the chief judge in writing, no later than 30 minutes after the publication of the results of the jump in question, with reference to the relevant points of FAI Sporting Code.
